History

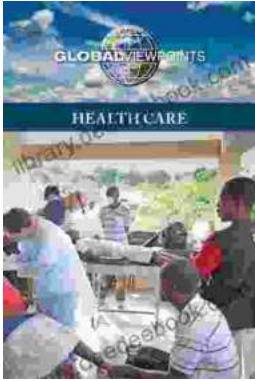

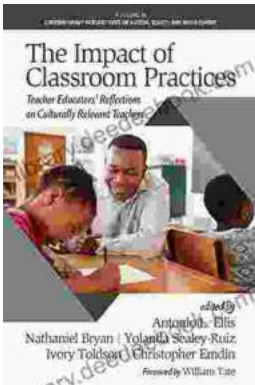
