- Neck circumference
- Chest circumference
- Back length (from the base of the neck to the base of the tail)

## Yarn Recommendations

When choosing yarn for your dog sweater, there are a few things to keep in mind. First, you'll want to choose a yarn that is soft and comfortable against your dog's skin. Once you have knitted the body of the sweater to the desired length, you'll need to divide the stitches for the body and sleeves. To do this, place a stitch marker at each shoulder. Then, knit the stitches between the markers for the body, and place the remaining stitches on two separate needles for the sleeves.

## **Step 4: Knitting the sleeves**

To knit the sleeves, continue knitting in stockinette stitch until the sleeves are the desired length. Then, bind off the stitches.

## **Step 5: Joining the sleeves to the body**

To join the sleeves to the body, sew the shoulder seams together using a yarn needle. Then, pick up the stitches around the armholes of the body

and the sleeves and knit them together using the three-needle bind off method.

## **Step 6: Finishing**

To finish the sweater, weave in any loose ends and trim any excess yarn. You can also add any embellishments you like, such as buttons or a collar.

- If you're a beginner knitter, start with a smaller size sweater. This will help you to get the hang of the basics before moving on to a larger project.

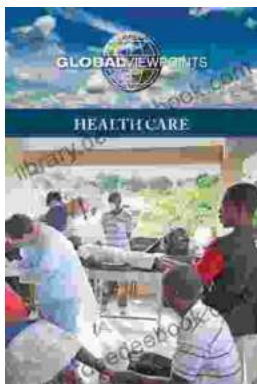

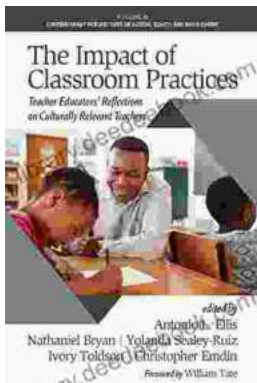
